

At-Home COVID-19 Test Kit Information

Receiving at-home test kits through NYP Benefits:

Employees who are enrolled in NYP medical benefits can receive up to eight at-home COVID-19 tests per plan member, per month without a physician's order and at no cost to the member. Each test kit contains two tests, so each plan member is allowed up to four kits per month. If you have a family of four covered members, you'll be eligible for 16 kits per month.

You are able to receive these **directly (without a co-pay) at any participating pharmacy** inperson, including any <u>CVS in-network pharmacy</u> (which includes Walgreens, Rite Aid and Duane Reade). You should purchase the kits at the pharmacy counter, as you'll be required to show your CVS pharmacy card, as you would with any other pharmacy prescription.

If you order a kit online or at a non-participating pharmacy, you will need to pay the total cost upfront and **submit a claim for reimbursement**. You can log into to the CVS portal to complete a <u>Claim Form</u>. Instructions can be found <u>here</u>. Please note the following:

- The COVID-19 test kits listed on this site are eligible for reimbursement.
- At this time, CVS/caremark Mail Order Pharmacy is not able to ship at-home kits.
- The eight at-home COVID-19 tests per plan member, per month are covered in addition to any diagnostic tests ordered by a medical provider.
- This coverage is effective January 15, 2022 there is no coverage for expenses incurred before January 15.

Receiving at-home test kits through the U.S. government:

You can additionally order free at-home COVID-19 test kits at <u>covidtests.gov</u>. Every home in the U.S. is eligible to order four free at-home COVID-19 tests. The tests and shipping are completely free. Orders will usually ship in 7-12 days.
